- Women Development Centre, WDC,
- Computer Aid, CA,
- Plants and Health Project, PHP

Kept us busy throughout 2014 and I will say 2014 has been an active and successful year for DUFA.

Women Development Centre - WDC.

Women Development Center has had a number of activities and visits from Denmark. The project is very successful and was in the final phase by the end of 2014.

Plants and Health Project – PHP Plant and Health Cooperative Society (PHCS)

Plants and Health Project committee is running new project in Aduku – Apac with the name Plant and Health Cooperative Society (PHCS). The former groups have now formed a cooperative and are growing among other things organic soya.

Computer Aid - CA

Computer aid was able to send a container with hospital equipment, school furniture, teaching aids materials and books. Computer Aid partner in Uganda was privilege to receive a visitor from DMRU who had a chance to visit some of the groups, schools and hospitals who receive the equipment we sent.
